

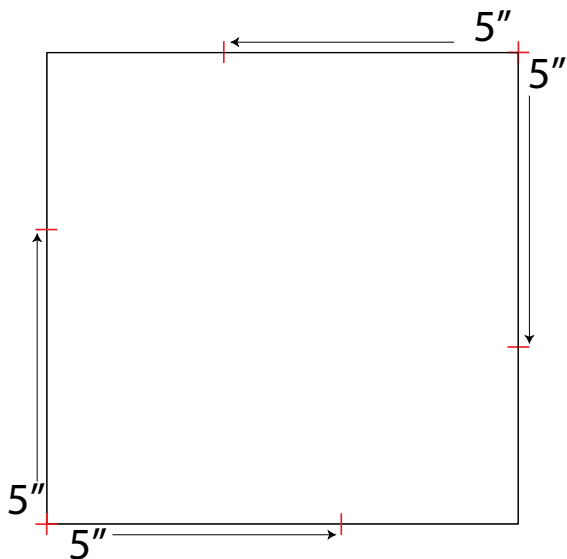
Indian Hatchet + Urban Amish Lesson 1

How to create templates.

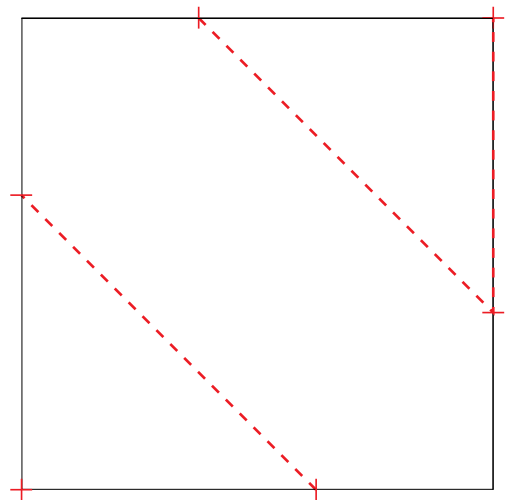
PAGE 1

TO CREATE HATCHET SHAPE:

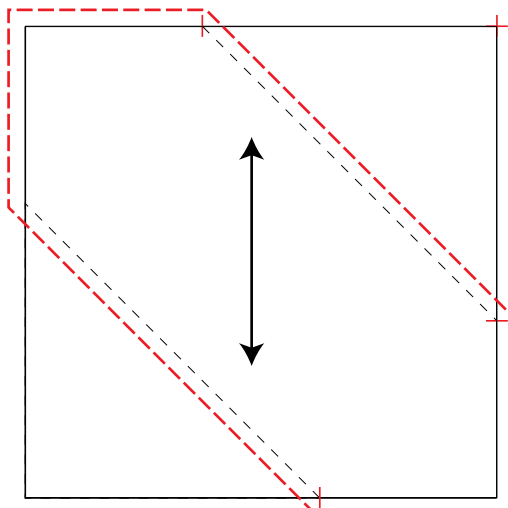
- 1 Draw an 8 inch square. Mark 5 inches in along 2 side in from 2 opposite corners.



- 2 Draw lines joining the points along each side.



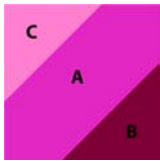
- 3 Add a 1/4" seam allowance all around the resulting "hatchet" shape and cut out.

Page 3 has a full size template to use if you rather not construct "from scratch".

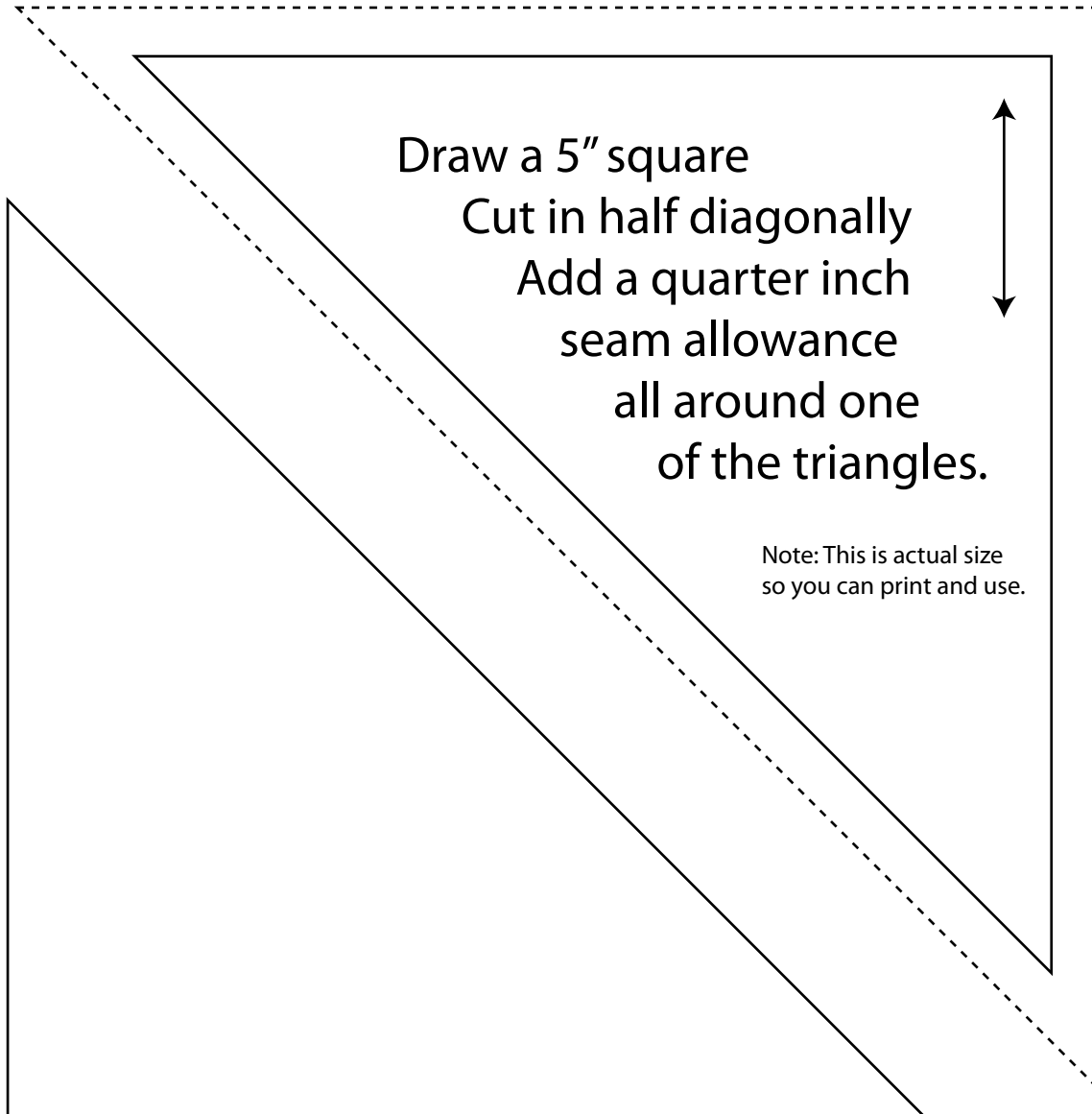
When using template align arrow shown with straight or cross grain of fabric



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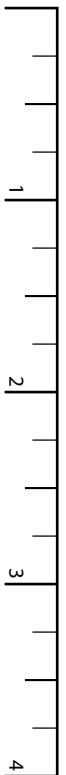
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TO CREATE TRIANGLE TEMPLATE FOR BOTH CORNERS:

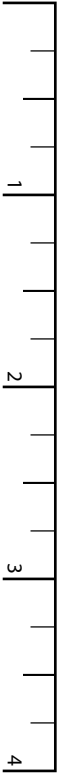


When using template align arrow shown with straight or cross grain of fabric

No-Template alternate method for triangle corners:
Cut a square 5 7/8" and cut in half along the diagonal.
