TODAY'S BIBLE VERSES: Micah chapter 6:8, 1 Thessalonians 5:11, 1 Timothy 4:12.


KEY WORDS: Being just and looking after people in need

BEFORE today's lesson:

- Make sure you have all the materials you need for the 'Welcome Zone' and 'Fun Zone' activities.
- Gather together all the required ingredients for 'Grub Zone'.
- Have enough *Kidzone* magazines for every child!
- Print off the 'Beyond the Zone' card.

When preparing your program, consider each of the 'zones' and how they will best work in your context.

You may like to mix up the order in which you do the 'zones'. You will, however, need to remember the 'Welcome Zone' (obviously) needs to start the session, the 'Zone In' section needs to follow the 'God Zone', and the 'Beyond the Zone' happens at home. Have fun!



GRUBZONE^{kz}

Use time to get to know your group.

BAKE and decorate Cheffy's fabulous cupcakes on page 13. Yummmm! Think about who you can share them with!

FUNZONE^{kz}

Choose an activity, based on the theme, to do in smaller groups.

MAKE Oliver's super-cute pencil or pen toppers (page 10). They're so easy, you could make a few to give to your friends! (Read the message at the bottom of the page.) Then use one of them to...

WRITE a story! Turn to page 5 to find out how to have the chance to see your story illustrated by *Kidzone's* amazing illustrator Rod!

READ about Reconciliation Week on pages 8 and 9.

CHAT with your kids about how important it is to notice unjust things in our community and do something about them. Explain to them what acting 'justly' means, and what social justice is. Talk about how much hard work was done by the people who fought for Aboriginal rights and discuss how doing the right and just thing is often difficult, but it's what God wants us to do.

GODZONE^{kz}

READ Micah chapter 6, verse 8, which tells us what God wants us to do. On your device, read a few different versions, such as the *Easy to Read Version (ERV)* for children to easily understand the words, and the *NIV*, which uses the words 'to act justly'.

DISCUSS ways we can act justly towards people who are disadvantaged in our community. Discuss the work The Salvation Army — and other organisations — do for people in need and explain that The Salvation Army believe that God has called them to look after people who need help.

DO the activities on pages 8 and 9 together.



ZONEIN^{kz}

-  **READ** The Champion (page 6), the great story about Mia and her eggs. Ask your children how they think Mia was acting justly.

-  **CHAT** about how everyone, no matter what their age is, can do something to help people who are disadvantaged. There's a great Bible verse to encourage young people — 1 Timothy 4:12.

-  **THINK** about ways we can act justly towards people, like Mia did. Perhaps you or your family could start a Red Shield Appeal digital fundraising page.

-  **PRAY** that God will show us how to act justly.

-  **TRY** out your drawing skills with 'Draw with Rod' on page 2. There are heaps more to do on our website, too! While you've got your pencils out, start colouring and enter the colouring competition on page 12.
-  **GET** your imagination into gear and enter the story competition on page 5.
-  **PRAY** for the people in our community who are in need and for ways we can help them. Thank God for the Salvos who help so many people.
