**TODAY'S BIBLE VERSES:** 1 Timothy 6:15;  
Philippians 2:6-7, Mark 10:45, Jeremiah 29:13


**KEY WORDS:** King, servant, crown

**BEFORE today's lesson:**

- Make sure you have all the materials you need for the 'Welcome Zone' and 'Fun Zone' activities.
- Gather together all the required ingredients for 'Grub Zone'.
- Have enough *Kidzone* magazines for every child!
- Print off the 'Beyond the Zone' card.

When preparing your program, consider each of the 'zones' and how they will best work in your context.

You may like to mix up the order in which you do the 'zones'. You will, however, need to remember the 'Welcome Zone' (obviously) needs to start the session, the 'Zone In' section needs to follow the 'God Zone', and the 'Beyond the Zone' happens at home. Have fun!

Use time to get to know your group.

**BAKE** Cheffy's delish raspberry origami pastries on page 10.

**DO** the right-royal quiz about kings on page 7 to get you in the mood to make your origami crown.

**READ** the message at the bottom of page 11.

**MAKE** Oliver's origami crown on page 11.

**LOOK HARD!** How good are you at finding kings? Do the Spottalottastuff on page 3.

**READ** the comic on pages 4 and 5.

**CHAT** about the comic. The two kids were surprised to see the kings travelling in this poor part of town ... where do you think they were going? Who were the kings looking for? Do you think they might have been surprised to find that the King of kings they had travelled so far to see was a little child?

**TALK** about how God had told them to find the King of kings, so they searched until they did. Remind the children that we can find Jesus today. "You will search for me, and when you search for me with all your heart, you will find me" (Jeremiah 29:13).

**TALK** about the wise men recognising Jesus for who he was — the King above all kings, the Son of God — even though he didn't look the way most people expect a king to look.

**READ** Sam on page 14. Chat about how Jesus was not your usual kind of king at all. Ask them if they know the only sort of crown Jesus wore. Think back to Easter ... the crown of thorns. Talk about how Jesus the King of kings gave up his life for us on the cross, to take away our wrongdoings so that we can have everlasting life with God.

**PRAY:** Thank God for Jesus, who loves us and wants us to be his friend and follower.

 **READ** the feature message on page 9. How did Jesus treat people? Can you think of some stories in the Bible where Jesus looked after people?

 **PRAY:** Thank Jesus that he is a king who loves his people and looks after us. Pray that he will show us how to be more like him.

 **DO** 28Kay's challenges on page 15. How will you serve (help) people you know this week?

 **WRITE** a letter to CK and send it in to KZHQ.

 **THERE'S** a heap of great puzzles to do — see how many you can do!
