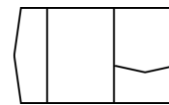

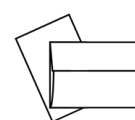

# Wording Guide

- Hosts' name(s) & titles spelled out
- Abbreviations for titles like "Mr." and "Mrs." BUT "Doctor," "The Reverend," and other titles are written out
- Reserve capitals for proper nouns, and if desired, the first letter of the year and/or reception line
- The bride's name precedes the groom's
- The conjunction between the bride and groom's names is usually "to," though Jewish tradition uses "and"
- Capitals for proper nouns, no punctuations, except in title, or separating words in the date/location
- Only use "honour of your presence" if the wedding is held in a place of worship. Formal invites use British spelling.
- Date is written in full, without numbers. Year is written without 'and' (ex. two thousand seventeen)
- Time in half hours are written "half after" & "in the morning" or "in the evening"
- Address numbers used for street addresses, but all else written in full words like "Avenue" and "Boulevard." No zip code
- Do not include details about gifts or a registry
