Intermediate Techniques

The ancient art of Encaustic Painting is enjoying a resurgence in popularity in the last several years. If you are intrigued or have been wanting to expand your knowledge about this art medium, join in

the fun with this Intermediate class as we delve deeper into encaustic painting. We will continue to explore the encaustic medium by learning more techniques such as applying texture, image transfer, masking, alcohol and india inks and shellac burn. We will complete an encaustic painting. (painting displayed is not necessarily the painting we will complete – students are encouraged to apply the techniques to create their own artwork)

Most supplies are included in your class fee however students will be asked to bring some general supplies for their own use**.
