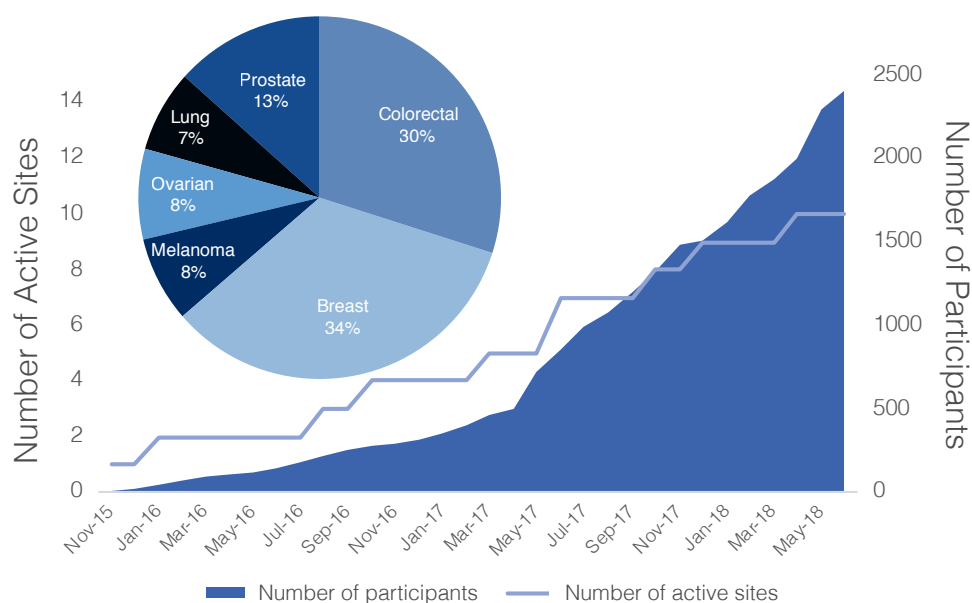
Thank you and farewell to Camille Le Sourd & Jackie Girgis
