

Line Notes

What is a line?

1. Elements of line, shape, form, value, space, color, texture, like ingredients
2. line line is a moving dot

3. contour lines are outline lines, indicate where one object begins + where one ends
4. line quality is the thickness or thinness of a line, create shadow form
5. blind contour drawing eye looking at the paper only the object 100% continuous line
6. Drawing is 50 percent observation
7. cross contour lines that cross over the contour

Summary

Line is a moving mark that can be used for contours, shading. Line can represent shadow and form by utilizing line quality.
