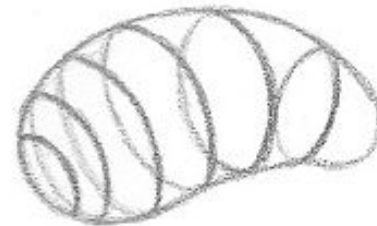
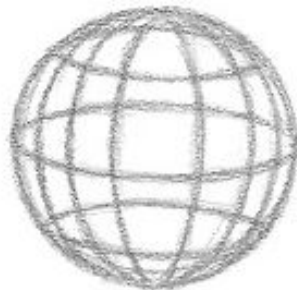

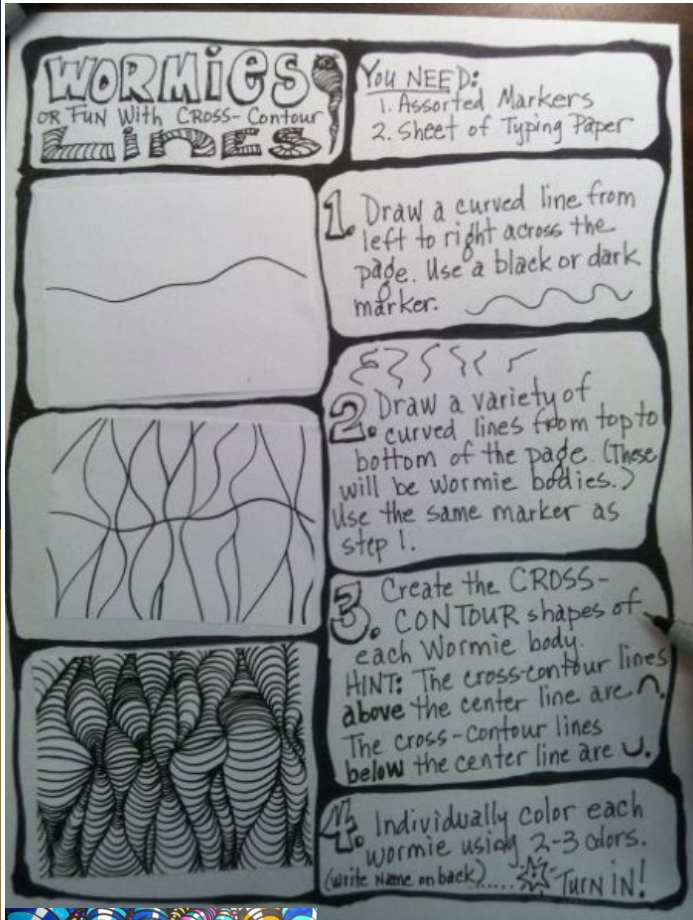

Vocabulary:

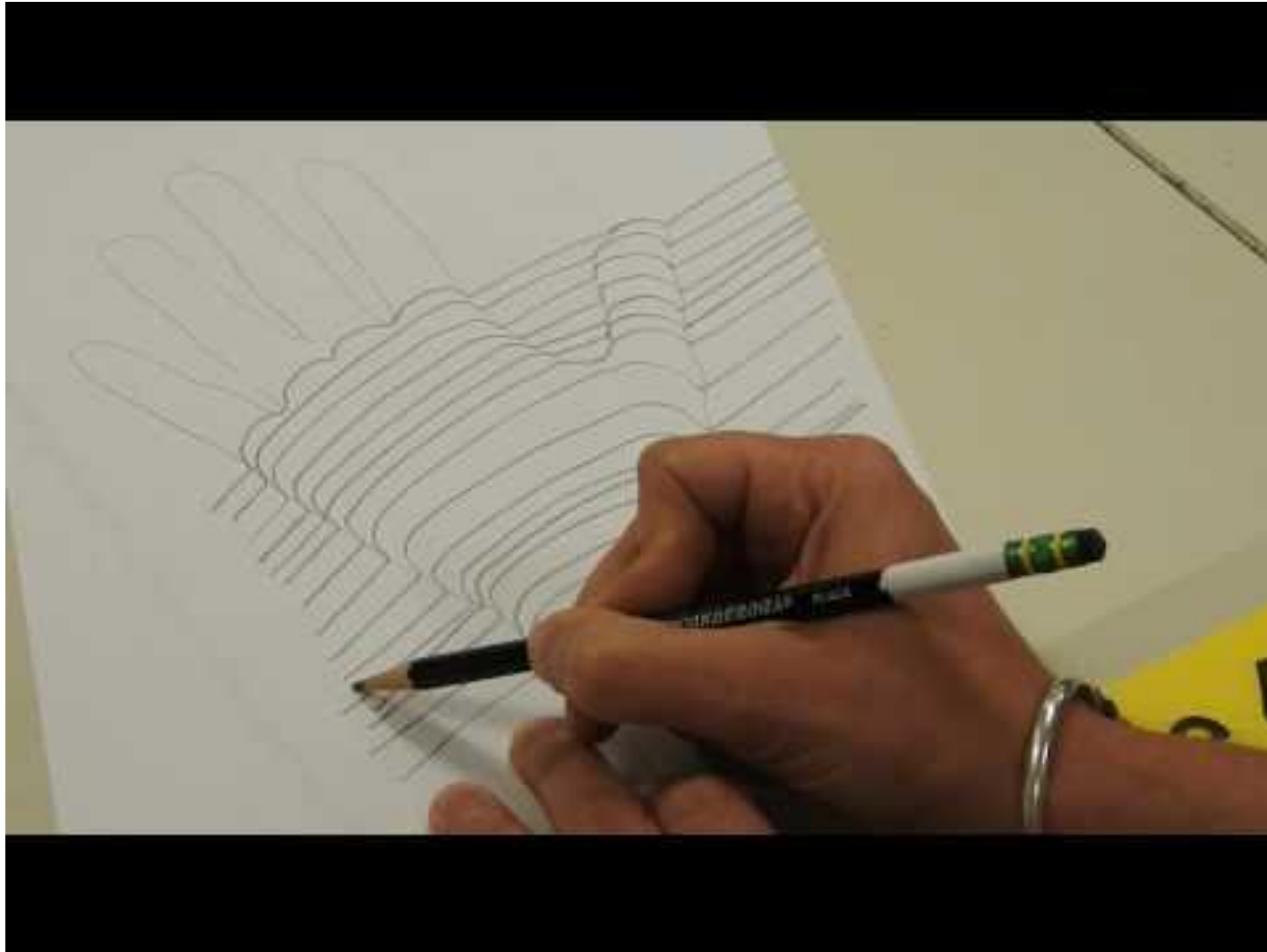
- **Line** - In terms of art, line is a moving dot.
- **Contour lines** - (outlines) Lines that communicate the boundaries of an object or parts of an object.
- **Line quality** - The thickness or thinness of a line. Line quality can be used to create the illusion of form.
- **Cross contour lines** - Lines that follow the contours or form of the object. These lines can be vertical, horizontal, or both.

WORMIES
OR FUN With CROSS-Contour
Lines

You NEED:
1. Assorted Markers
2. Sheet of Typing Paper

1. Draw a curved line from left to right across the page. Use a black or dark marker.

2. Draw a variety of curved lines from top to bottom of the page. (These will be wormie bodies.) Use the same marker as step 1.

3. Create the CROSS-CONTOUR shapes of each Wormie body.
HINT: The cross-contour lines above the center line are \cap .
The cross-contour lines below the center line are \cup .

4. Individually color each wormie using 2-3 colors.
