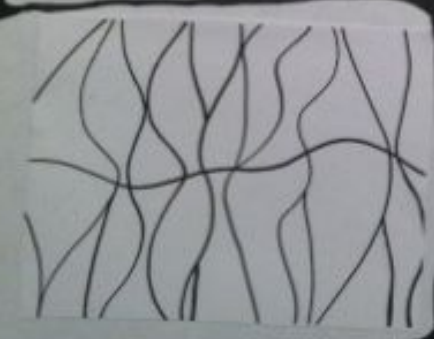
OR FUN With CROSS-Contour



**You NEED:**  
1. Assorted Markers  
2. Sheet of Typing Paper






1. Draw a curved line from left to right across the page. Use a black or dark marker.



2. Draw a variety of curved lines from top to bottom of the page. (These will be wormie bodies.) Use the same marker as step 1.



3. Create the CROSS-CONTOUR shapes of each Wormie body.  
HINT: The cross-contour lines above the center line are . The cross-contour lines below the center line are .

4. Individually color each wormie using 2-3 colors. (write name on back).....  TURN IN!



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
