GENERAL INFORMATION – SUMMER SEASON 2019/20

This document will hopefully answer any questions you have in regards to joining our Club. Please ensure you also read our important player Terms & Conditions of Registration.

The Waverley Basketball Club belongs to the Melbourne East Basketball Association (MEBA). As a junior only club, our members' ages range from 6 to 23 years old. Our Club is made up entirely of volunteers and we cannot function without support from our parent community.

Information:

New players wishing to join Waverley Basketball Club can join the Saturday Competition. Saturday teams train once a week (Monday to Thursday nights from 4.30pm) and play on Saturdays against other local junior domestic clubs.

Waverley Basketball Club teams generally train at the following venues:

- Jells Park Primary School (Gym entrance via Homestead Drive, Wheelers Hill)
- Glen Waverley South Primary School (Gym entrance via Watsons Rd, Glen Waverley)
- Brentwood Secondary College (Gym entrance via Heath St, Glen Waverley) and
- Mallauna College (Gym entrance via Tirana Street, Mitcham)

We do NOT accept any requests for training nights or venues as your child's training night will be determined by their Coach only.

Team Information:

Team lists for your child's team will be released at our Club Presentation Day. This is held after the previous seasons Grand Finals i.e. Summer Teams will be released at the Winter Season Club Presentation Day. If you cannot attend this day, please email our Selection Coordinator at teams@waverleybasketball.net

It's important to know that no refunds for registrations will be issued for either: (1) for any child that is withdrawn ONE WEEK prior to the release of team lists at Club Presentation

Day OR (2) once team lists have been submitted to the Nunawading Basketball Junior Domestic Competitions Administrator.

In the school holidays, after our Club Presentation Day and the release of team lists, you can expect to hear from your child's Coach as to what night and where your child's training is to be held.

Fixture information:

Fixtures for Saturday games can be found on the Nunawading Basketball website (usually from Thursday) at nunawadingbasketball.com.au Please be aware that there can be changes right up until game day.

Should teams need to forfeit, they will need to pay the \$90 penalty fee.

Game Times:

Games generally go for 2 x 18 minute halves. Saturday games start with Under 8's playing from 8am. Under 8 teams play in the earliest timeslots followed by Under 10's then Under 12's etc. Your game time and venue may change each week. The Team Manager for your child's team should inform you of when & where you need to be. Please arrive 10-15 minutes prior to the start of a game. Games are played at a number of venues, including:

- Nunawading Basketball Stadium,
- Ringwood Basketball Stadium (The Rings),
- Forest Hill Secondary College,
- The Knox School and
- Mullauna Secondary College.

Fees:

- Saturday Team Registration Fees: Child 1 - \$118; Child 2 - \$88; Child 3 - \$58 (payable upon online registration). A team photo is included with registration fees.
- Midweek Team Registration Fee (no training sessions): Child 1 - \$78; Child 2 - \$48; Child 3 - \$13
- Team Sheet Fees (Under 8 – Under 14): Once the season starts, all families must pay team sheet fees to the Team Manager (payable in full by round 3). Each team pays \$38 per week to the venue they are playing at. To work out team sheet fees for the season – it is \$38 per week x the number of games per season ÷ the number of players in the team. This then = the amount each player pays. For example: \$38 x 18 games = \$684. If there are 7 players in the team, each player would pay \$95 for team sheet fees. ($684 \div 7 = 97$ per player).
- Team Sheet Fees (Under 16 and above): There will be an automatic charge of \$80 for team sheet fees payable at time of registration.
- Stadium Entry: All Coaches, Team Managers, players and spectators over 12 years old need to pay the \$3.00 stadium entry once (at the first stadium). If you are

attending multiple venues or games, make sure you get a stamp on your hand that gives you free re-entry to any stadium. Seniors card holders pay \$1.00 entry. Coaches will be reimbursed their season's entry fees by Nunawading Basketball via direct EFT into their nominated account.

Uniforms:

All new players MUST attend the photo & uniform day to be fitted and to purchase a uniform. New Under 8 and Under 10 players receive a free player's uniform.

Community:

All of our members/families are encouraged to be active within our Club. Please make yourself available to help out when needed. There are many ways in which you can contribute i.e. Coaching, Team Managing or joining our Committee! Please remember that ALL of our Club participants are volunteers that give up their time so that all of our children can take to the court every week.
