CHIANG MAI, THAILAND & PHNOM PENH, CAMBODIA - SEACS Program

IPSL SEACS Program Fee Includes: Tuition and academic fees; academic transcript; on-site and on-line orientation and pre-departure materials; service placement and supervision; academic excursions; health insurance. airfare from Bangkok to Phnom Penh (students must pay for transportation from Chiang Mai to Bangkok). In Chiang Mai, a meal stipend for dinner and breakfast for the weekdays will be provided and full accommodation in international student dorms. In Phnom Penh, students stay in a homestay or group apartment with partial board included.

What's typically NOT Included: Passport fees; visa fees (both for Thailand and Cambodia); vaccine fees; international airfare; books; all lunches and meals on weekends in Chiang Mai; some meals in Phnom Penh; local transportation; inexpensive school uniforms in Chiang Mai (required uniform accessories can be purchased on campus and the black skirt and white blouse (females) and black slacks and white shirt (males) as well as black shoes can be brought from home; and personal spending money. A small monthly fee for air conditioning and water utilities in Chiang Mai is also not included and payable directly to the building management. Students are responsible for their own bedding which can be purchased in Thailand for a nominal price or ordered on-line in advance from the Thailand program director.
