ST MARY'S CHURCH Newton Flotman

We are open regularly now at 11am every Sunday for a Service of the Word or Private Prayer (depending on the

ministry team rota). Zoom services will continue to run alongside 'live' services at 10am. Please see tasvalley.org website, Tas Valley Ministry Facebook page /Tas Valley Families Facebook group, church and village noticeboards for updates.

We hope to welcome as many as possible to services/private prayer at Newton, but please understand that there will be some necessary adaptations to what we can offer, I've outlined them below so that you know what to expect. *Please note they are subject to change in response to Diocesan advice and guidance updates received.*

There will be a limited capacity and one way system in operation. Both doors will be wide open for ventilation and the heating will not be on, so please be mindful of this. As you enter sanitise your hands and you will be guided to a seat, those from the same household will be seated together and there will be a pew left between households. Private prayer is encouraged while music is played, prior to the service. We want people who attend to be as comfortable as possible so, in addition to the measures we have put in place, please feel free to wear a face mask. For services of the word the screen may be used to project the service or single use service sheets, there will be worship songs for us to listen to, but at time of going to press we are unable to sing in church. We are also unable to provide refreshments after the service at this time.

As well as the regular 11am slot each Sunday look out for other opportunities to worship – we are looking forward to ECO church in the afternoon of Sunday 2nd August!

Insects Glowing in Our Hedgerows

Last month, members of the Wolfe family took part in a Scouts ‘Virtual Camp’ weekend with the 43rd Saxlingham Scout Group. Tasks and activities were set via Zoom and Facebook, whilst children camped in their own gardens, or in dens made in their homes.

During the weekend we took part in many activities, one being a mini-beast hunt. We ticked off all sorts of millipedes, butterflies, spiders and moths. But the best beast we found was not on our list. Imagine our surprise when, at the end a night-time stroll, we spotted glowing dots throughout the bushes either side of the path we had walked along. The lights were as bright as little LEDs, glowing a very specific green.

The lights, measuring about 8mm long, were being produced by female glow worms, and the species found in Norfolk is *Lampyris noctiluca*. These small bio-luminescent invertebrates are more beetle-like than worm-like, with its scientific name translation meaning 'night shining fire lamp'. The males have hard cases which cover the wings when they are not in use, and the females are wingless and dark brown.

During June and July, females sit whilst emitting a yellowish-green light to attract males to mate, but timings can vary from year to year and place to place. The females normally start glowing at around 10pm and can carry on until after midnight.



So, if you find yourself out in the dark during these warm evenings, take a closer look in the hedgerows, and you might be lucky enough to see this fascinating display for yourself. You will need to use your own night vision as torch-light will drown out the tiny lights!
