

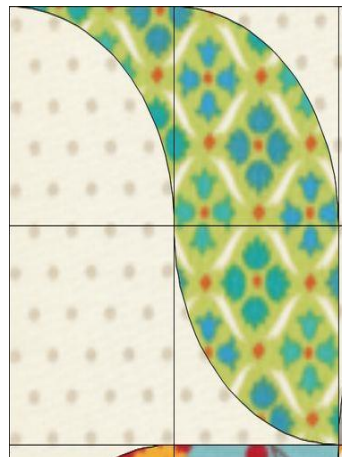
CUT A ROUND RULER

- The "one inch rule" – Cut the hole in the background frame ONE INCH smaller than the circle you want to set in.



Does block have space around quarter circle or not?



Example: To prepare a 5 1/2" drunkards path block with 1/2" space around arc.

- Means that quarter circle is 5" in radius; i.e. 10" circle
- Cut background square at 6" (allow for trimming)
- Cut insert square at 6"
- Cut arc in background square at 9" marking on ruler (remember "one inch rule")
- Cut arc in insert square at 10" marking on ruler

Tips:

- Makes quarter circles in half inch increments
- Eliminate seam allowance marking to get quarter inch increments
