### **PRE-FORUM COURSE 1**

**Clinical, relational aspects and patient's empowerment in general practice through the methodology of simulated patient.**

**A workshop about the "patient's voice" and about professionalism in the training of general practitioners**

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The workshop will offer an experience about holistic approach in GP. The specific clinical method in general medicine can be described as a holistic approach derived from the environment in which primary care happens. The clinical, the relational and the social aspects are mixed in every consultation. The Simulation is the exemplary methodology that allows the learning of each components simultaneously, in a "natural way" during a typical consultation.

The environment of general medicine is determinate from a list of routinely facts and actions among which emerge sometimes the uncertainty, the variability, the turbulence and the complexity embedded in the history of the patient.

We bring in the classroom the voice of the patient using the high-fidelity Simulation. Our clinical cases are directly collected from real stories and modified to maintain privacy. The basic session includes a consultation, followed by a patient and doctor interview, a classroom discussion and a final feedback that investigates the learners' global learning.
