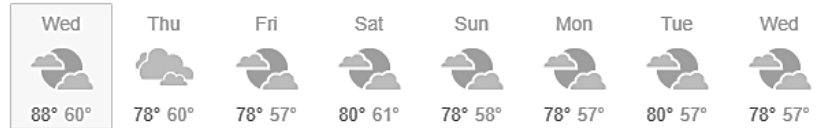

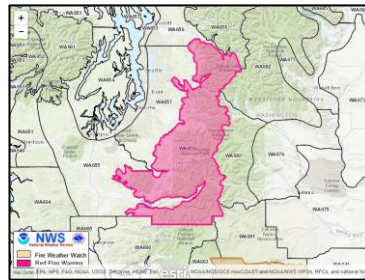
## 90's | RED FLAG | FEMA DECLARATION

WESTERN WASHINGTON				
AIR QUALITY MODERATE	FIRE WEATHER RED FLAG	RIVER FLOODING NONE	WIND GUSTS 8-17	EXCESSIVE HEAT 80's-90's

**SUMMARY:** Forecasted to be Hurricane Dorian FEMA has approved a Presidential Disaster Declaration ahead of landfall. Red Flag Warning Western Slopes of Cascades. Excessive Heat today with temps in the 90's.



**WEATHER:** Moderate risk of heat-related impacts for heat-sensitive individuals or those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. Monitor children, elderly, and pets for dehydration and heat related illnesses.



**FIRE DANGER:** Fire Weather Watch upgraded to Red Flag Warning for western slopes of central and southern Cascades generally above 1500 Feet. Use extreme caution and report any smoke sightings immediately to 911.

## Hurricane Preparation #HurricanePrep

- Keep all trees and shrubs well trimmed.
- Place valuables and personal papers in a waterproof container on the highest level of your home.
- Cover windows with hurricane shutters or pre-cut plywood.
- Create a Ready kit with enough supplies for at least three days, consider needs of children, pets and elderly.
- Develop an evacuation plan and where to reconnect with family.
- Bring in all outdoor furniture and anything else that is not secured.
- Set refrigerator to the coldest setting.
- Fill gas tank.
