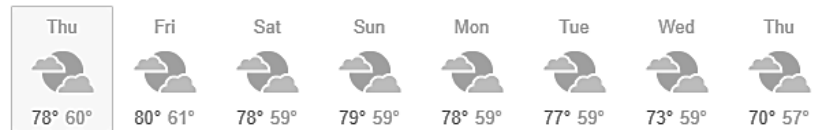

TROPICAL STORM BARRY | 80'S DRY

WESTERN WASHINGTON

SUMMARY: Tropical Storm Barry named and affecting Gulf Coast States. NW Teams placed on standby to support Gulf States response operations with coordination and disaster relief. Region drying begins with temperatures near 80 by Friday and throughout the weekend.



WEATHER: Partly sunny, high near 73. Overnight mostly cloudy, with a low around 58. Northwest wind 6 to 14 mph. Friday partly sunny, high near 76. Overnight partly cloudy, with a low around 59. North northwest wind 9 to 13 mph becoming east northeast in the evening.

TROPICAL STORM BARRY:

During hurricane season Pacific Northwest teams deploy in support of Response Operations to assist states overwhelmed by large scale incidents. These incidents are known as **Type 1 Incidents**, the largest and most complex.



FEMA Region VI and the states of Texas and Louisiana are preparing for initial storm-related impacts. Rainfall amounts in New Orleans exceeded 6-9 inches in the last 24 hours, resulting in flooding; first responders have already responded to 250+ related emergency calls Food, Water, and Sheltering.
