UNSTABLE WEATHER | 70'S | WIND GUSTS

SUMMARY: Lightning hits Seattle skyscraper. Heavy rain forecasted for parts of the weekend. Topical activity is high in both the Pacific and Atlantic. Some areas may see thunderstorm activity, especially near foothills.

















WEATHER: Partly sunny, high near 72. West southwest wind 9 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Saturday cloudy, high near 70. Saturday Night rain likely, chance of precipitation is 70% with precipitation amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch possible. Sunday heavy rain, high near 65. Chance of precipitation is 100%. New precipitation amounts between a half and three-quarters of an inch possible. **Thunderstorms are possible. Monitor weather conditions. When thunder roars, go indoors!**



SEATTLE LIGHTNING STRIKE:

KOMO News reported lightning might have hit the under-construction new Rainier Tower skyscraper last night. Lightning is very dangerous and should be taken seriously at ALL times.



TROPICAL DISTURBANCES: Both the Pacific and Atlantic remain active entering the weekend. Tropical Disturbance #9 may become a tropical depression or storm by Monday affecting Florida. In the Pacific several areas of tropical weather formation have developed to include Tropical Storm Kiko currently projected to track north of the Hawaiian Islands.
