SUMMARY: Cooler temps today, increasing into the holiday. Regional fire danger is HIGH. Some areas imposing temporary ban on discharge of fireworks. Tornado touchdown confirmed in Portland, OR.

WEATHER: Chance of showers with below normal temperatures. Dry, mostly cloudy for Wednesday and Independence Day, near to above normal temperatures. Thunderstorms possible mostly near the Cascades.

FLASH FLOOD WATCH: North Central Washington, including Chelan and Okanogan counties due to slow moving thunderstorms producing heavy rainfall which may result in flash flooding on and near burn scars.
