VACCINE	Initial Series for animals under 16 wks old	Initial Series for animals over 16	BOOSTER

RABIES	1 dose as early as 8 - 12 wks	1 dose	1 year after last dose, then every 1 - 3 years as per county regulations
DISTEMPER (FVRCP)	3 doses given 3 - 4 wks apart First dose at 6-8 wks	2 doses 3 - 4 wks apart	1 year after last dose of initial series then every 3 years. *
Leukemia (FELV)	2 doses given 3 - 4 wks apart. First at 8 - 12 wks	2 doses 3 - 4 wks apart **	If no risk of exposure, no booster needed. If at risk, give booster 1 year after last dose then annually ***

RABIES	1 dose as early as 12 wks	1 dose	1 year after last dose, then every 1 - 3 years as per county regulations
DISTEMPER (DA2PPC)	3 doses given 3 - 4 wks apart First dose at 6-8 wks	1 dose	If vaccinated when under 16 wks - booster 1 year later, the every 3 years. If vaccinated over 16 wks, no booster needed, next vaccine in 3 years
