

Generic Hunt Shot List

WMT=Wide, Medium, Tight

At Camp:

- Set up the day/Hunt
- Establishing shot of lodge/camp
- Getting in truck/cart
- Tights of hands and face driving
- Walking to stand (WMT)

In Stand:

- Set up again now that we are in tree.
 - Need to know Who, what, when where, why.
 - Tell weather, story of particular deer, date, etc etc. Anything I need to know as a viewer
- Shots of products (WMT)
 - Bow
 - Release
 - Gear
 - Camo
- Tights of things
 - Eyes
 - Hands
 - Boots
 - Leaves
 - Deer
 - Squirrels
 - Anything really
- Establishing in tree.
 - Big sweeping shot of stand area
- Animals (WMT)
- Cool stuff (WMT)
- Animals comes in
 - Walking in (WMT) if you can
 - Leading shot
 - Over the shoulder if you can
 - If you can get a shot of hunter and animal in same frame, Do so.
 - Get shot
 - Follow deer until they are out of sight, come right back to hunter for reaction
 - Follow deer until down come back to hunter

- Follow deer unless it doesn't die pretty then get off animal and get back to hunter
- Reaction shot
 - Try to capture the emotion of this
 - Maybe have them re-do this if it isn't good (requires some acting)
 - Roll a long time after shot. Let them talk and take it in. Guide the conversation with them
 - Cut Aways
 - Clipping in release
 - drawing
 - pulling be off hanger
 - stopping animal tight of eyes drawn or cocked.
 - Rattling if used
 - Grunting if used
 - any other hunting method used get shots of it
- Recovery
 - walk behind hunter don't ever be first to deer or animal
 - Frame them correctly and check audio (do this all the time, wear ear buds always)
 - Once they have done the recovery and you are happy with it get tights
 - Tights of hands on animal
 - Tights of arrow hole
 - tights of cool features
 - Shots showing off antlers tight
 - etc
 - etc

This is about the most basic breakdown I can give you. Try new things and think outside the box.
