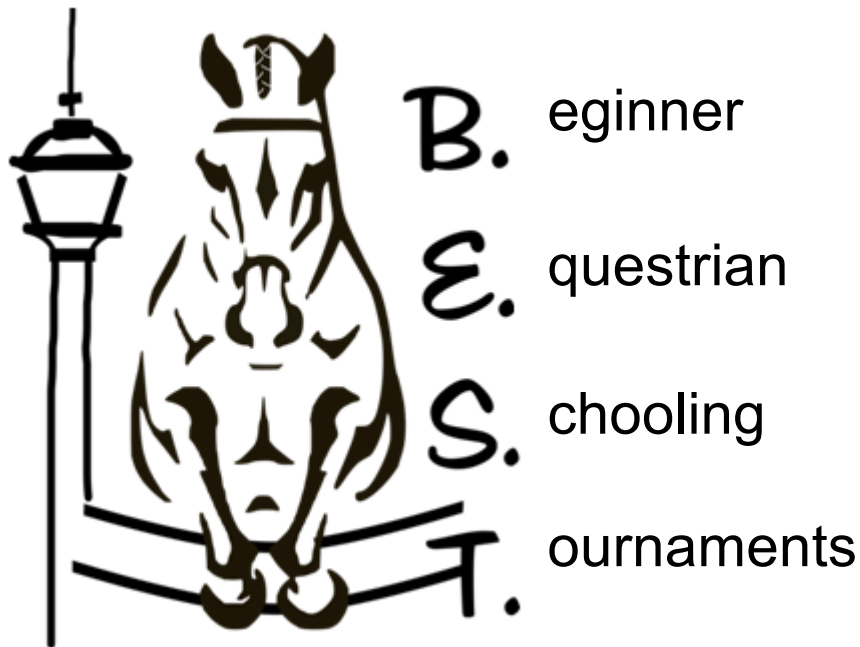

Attention ALL Competitors

Class schedule is subject to change! It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the daily schedule of classes posted on notice boards at the show office. Championship presentations will take place after placing last class of division. Please remain at ring with your horse to receive your awards.

All breaks will be announced at the show.

General Rules:

1. The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list.
2. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, owner, trainer, manager, or rider from the horse show without compensation should that individual exhibit dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior or harm to a horse.
3. Any acts of discourtesy, or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the horse show and the owner shall forfeit all fees.
4. Inhumane treatment of a horse including polling, rapping, or other abuse shall not be tolerated. Violation of this rule shall result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of all fees and prizes.
5. Competitors will not be issued numbers until entry / waiver forms are received in the Show Office. Please sign the Release and Waiver of Liability form on your entry form..
6. Numbers must be worn while mounted

HARD HATS AND ATTIRE

It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.
