I have a friend from another printing ministry that calls and asks the question, "Do you want to serve God today?" He has asked that several times and I always answer, "I thought I was..." since usually that question is accompanied with a request for my help with something. I don't mind, though. It is always my desire to serve God.

If we are serious about following Christ **service to God is a high priority** in our lives. One important area of service is evangelism. I wonder how many lives are lost daily because Christians have not made Christ's command found in the Great Commission a priority in their lives.

I believe there are souls that are ready to hear the gospel. They are waiting for a direct contact from someone who is willing to give them the truth.

We have received a request for Spanish tracts to accompany scripture portions, New Testaments and Bibles in a freight container headed for Honduras. At this time we only have a few thousand **God's Simple Plan of Salvation** tracts in Spanish that we can send.

Currently we estimate that it costs \$30 per thousand for our two-color tracts. We would like to send 100,000 tracts in this container. We need to raise \$3,000 for this particular need in Honduras.

These tracts will be cherished by faithful tract distributors because of the clarity of the message and the beauty of the tracts. It has been my experience that often when tracts or scriptures are given to people in these foreign countries, they stop what they are doing and begin reading the message.

Some years ago I traveled with Dr. Guy Altizer to Honduras for a ministry trip. I had the privilege of giving gospel tracts to pastors at a pastor's conference there. They could use as many tracts as we can produce!

Please join with us in the ministry of printing gospel tracts. Your gift will help us continue the ministry my grandfather Ford Porter prayed for 85 years ago. We want to encircle the world with the gospel, and we have the means to do so as the Lord provides.
