

Trip to Timber Ridge

(32 bar reel for three couples in a four-couple longwise set)

- 1 – 4 1st couple turn with the right hand and cast off one place as 2nd couple step up on bars 3 – 4.
- 5 – 8 1st woman with 2nd couple and 1st man with 3rd couple dance right hands across. 1st couple finish facing 1st corners.
- 9 – 16 1st couple dance corner pass and turn with 1st corners, 1st couple pass right shoulder in centre and dance corner pass and turn with 2nd corners. 1st couple end corner pass and turn by dancing towards each other and pull back right shoulder to finish back to back in the centre facing opposite sides.
- 17 – 24 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance double triangles; on bars 23-24, 1st couple, with two pas de basque, dance out to 2nd place own side and pull back right shoulder to face in.
- 25 – 32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance six hands round and back.

Repeat, having passed a couple.

Linda is from the county of East Lothian, birthplace of the Saltire, Scotland's national flag. The Saltire is flown throughout the weekend at Timber Ridge. Corners pass & turn and double triangles depict the diagonal cross on the flag.
