We meet on Tuesdays in the Chapel and then Chestnut Lodge or the Tithe Barn. Cancer patients and their carers meet on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and Parkinson's Disease patients and carers on the second Tuesday of each month.

All patients and carers are very welcome, of any denomination or none. The ministry they will receive is Christian – God's love, with our love as His channel. The atmosphere is informal, warm and caring. Church ministers of any denomination and health care professionals are also very welcome.

The day starts with music in the Chapel from 12 noon. An optional Eucharist (Holy Communion Service) starts at 12.30 pm including prayer with the laying on of hands for any desiring it. If you are attending the Eucharist you are asked to arrive by 12.20 pm. All are welcome to receive Holy Communion with us if that is your custom.




