The format used for publishing *Effective Maths* lessons is changing from the flash-based movie.exe files to html

WHY IS EFFECTIVE MATHS DOING THIS?

Adobe Flash has been a landmark technology: it ruled the web world. To some extent, it was Flash which created the internet we know and love, as it gave us the ability to watch videos, listen to music, and play games online... but now, it's time to say goodbye and move to html.

Content in HTML5 is more likely to play flawlessly in any web browser, although Chrome may be the best one to use. In addition, it is lightweight and downloads quickly and adapts to different screen sizes.

The change of publishing format takes effect from the last unit of work for the 2017/18 year - patterns and relationships - which is online now. Most of the lessons are published in html.

Using the new format is straightforward

- As before, download and unzip/extract the file. The file will now say 'presentation' at the end rather than 'CD'. **You must make sure you have pressed 'extract all files'**.
- Open the folder.
- Click on the 'index.html' icon
