ACRYLIC

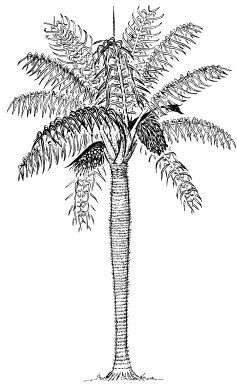
Acrylic tables or accessories adds a bit of retro whimsy.
