Mr. Bell was already a volunteer member of Siloam’s Capital Campaign team. On the professional front, he is a Chartered Professional Accountant and holds an Honours Degree in Commerce from the University of Manitoba. He was most recently working in Winnipeg’s residential real estate sector.

Mr. Bell was also a senior executive of the Winnipeg Football Club for 12 years and has served on numerous boards including the Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce and Eastview Community Church.

“I am thrilled to be joining such an iconic organization as Siloam Mission,” said Mr. Bell. *“I look forward to implementing the philosophies of servant leadership and empowering the people around me to continue helping our city’s most vulnerable citizens.”*

Mr. Bell takes over from Dr. Garry Corbett, who is retiring once a full transition has taken place.
