VILUS PIERRE



How rewarding it is to talk about yourself! I find that the most real and captivating story is the one a human can draw from himself. It is even more of a blessing when time allows us to put it on paper during our existence.

I am Vilus Pierre, born January 14, 1954 in Haiti, the sixth child of a family of 11. My father was a cabinetmaker and my mother a seamstress and businesswoman. I started my primary education at the age of 15. At age 21, I started high school. On September 4, 1974, at age 20, the Lord called me

I was Baptized on January 16, 1977, since then I have been serving the Lord. The week before my baptism, I preached in an outdoor service, after the preaching, a soul came to the Lord. I was as happy as a fisherman catching his first fish.

After graduating from high school in 1982, my former pastor, Jérôme Dorcin, sent me to a Bible School in Gonaïves, Haiti. I married Rose-Marie Lafleur on December 22, 1984. I came to Montreal on December 22, 1985. God gave us a girl after our marriage, her name is Rodelyne Pierre. In 1988, I went back to Sainte-Croix polyvalent school, in Montreal. At the end of my cycle, graduating, I decided to continue in Cegep. In 1992, I began my theological studies at the Acadia Faculty of Theology in Montreal. After obtaining my Bachelor's degree in Theology, I resolved to continue the Master's degree in Theology. And by the Grace of God, I obtained my Master's degree in Theology at the same University on Saturday, May 18, 1999. During this same period, I was a member of the Christian Alliance and Missionary Church led by Pastor Manais Dumont in Rivière-des-Prairies. In 2004, I was chosen to be the pastor of the Baptist Christian Worshipers' Church on Papineau Avenue in Montreal resigning in March 2015. From April 2016 until today, my family and I exercise our ministries of preaching, teaching, encouragement, and edification at the Church of the Nazarene in Rivière-des-Prairies with Pastor Lovanis Jean -Louis.

In the end, by the Grace of God, I am a pastor, speaker and writer. I have in my assets title books: L'Autorité pastorale dans les Églises Évangéliques Haïtiennes ; Les Enfants des chrétiens ; une génération en crise ; De la Poussière au Trône ; Les Avantages d'être chrétien et mon cinquième, La Réforme Protestante, ce que tous les chrétiens devraient connaître.
