Nottingham Islam Information Centre Annual Report & Progress (2016-2017)

Opened on Saturday 1st October 2016, the Nottingham Islam Information Centre has provided and facilitated the following classes, activities and services to the general public of Nottingham:-

Rattil Qur'an School – Successfully run by qualified teachers, teaching up to 70 children how to read and memorise the Qur'an with Tajweed.

Sunday Islamic School – Giving the children an opportunity to experience an Islamic School Day learning about the Basics of Islam, Fiqh, Seerah, Tafseer with additional P.E and Creative Arts.

Youth Club – Weekend Youth Clubs allowing children to play on the numerous games and activities provided in the Youth Centre. Up to 20 children and parents have access to playing Pool, Table Tennis, Table Football, Basketball Shootout, PS3, Xbox 360 and WiiU consoles.

Women Arabic Classes – Delivered by qualified Arabic speaking teachers, teaching women the Arabic language on intermediary and advanced levels.

Women Qur'an Classes – Delivered by qualified Qur'an teachers, teaching women how to read the Qur'an with Tajweed.

Women Tea & Coffee Mornings – Facilitating a weekly social gathering for women.

Islamic Reminders – Competent teachers deliver weekly Islamic reminders on various topics from Seerah through to Tafseer for men and women.

Islam 101 – Teaching new Muslims the Basics of Islam, Taharah, Salah and Du'a.

Mum & Tots – Facilitating a weekly Social gathering for women and their children.

Daily Salah – Facilitating 5 daily prayers for the Muslim community.

School & Scouts Visits – Providing basic education on the religion of Islam for local school children and teachers to coincide with the states' religious education curriculum. Facilitating local Cubs and Scouts Groups enhancing their knowledge on Islam to earn the Worlds Faith Activity Badge.

External School Visits – Regular attendance to the various Primary and Secondary Schools throughout Nottinghamshire to teach the children a wide range of topics on Islam.



Soup Kitchen & Food Patrols – Providing a monthly Soup Kitchen for the homeless to enjoy a hot meal with dessert and drinks. Provide items of clothing and assistance. Regular Food Patrols are conducted in the City Centre of Nottingham providing hot drinks, biscuits and sandwiches for the homeless.

Da'wah Table – Weekly information stalls situated in the heart of Nottingham's City Centre providing information about Islam to the general public.

Da'wah Literature Storage – Housing a storage room full of Islamic literature in various languages for local ISOC's and other Da'wah Teams across the country to obtain.

Mail Orders – Frequently sending out Da'wah Literature and Qur'ans in various languages to the different Da'wah Teams, non-Muslims and new Muslims across the UK and abroad.

Hijama Service – Providing a small Hijama Clinic for men to undergo the cupping procedure.

Nikah Service – Providing a Nikah Service for the Muslim Community. Certificates are issued at the time of Nikah.

Prison Visits – Regular Prison Visits to inmates who have reverted to Islam and provide assistance, answers to questions and ongoing mentorship.

Islamic Lectures – Providing regular Islamic Lectures by World Renowned Speakers for the Muslim Community to benefit from.

Outdoor Activities – Yearly Hikes and Camping for Reverts and general Muslims – men only.

Ramadan Iftaar Evenings – Providing Iftaar and Dinners for the Muslim Community throughout Ramadan.

Eid Dinners – Providing a grand Eid Dinner exclusively for Reverts on the Day of Eid so they are not left out during the Islamic festivities.

Centre Hire – Open for the Muslim Community to hire out the different rooms within the centre for different functions from selling Islamic attire to Nikah & Walima celebrations.
