Overview

The Certified Environmental, Safety and Health Trainer (CET) of the Board of Certified Safety Professional (BCSP) is a certification held by those with experience in designing, developing, and delivering safety, health and environmental training. The CET measures an individual's knowledge of the theory and practice of basic adult education. It also confirms knowledge and experience in the SH&E specialty area(s) in which they teach.

The GLC philosophy is to enable and equip the participants with the knowledge, skills, and support they require in order to pass the exam. The instructor, Prof. Tariq Aldowaisan, has hands-on safety and extensive instructional experiences, as well as BCSP professional certifications in ASP, CSP and CET.

CET Exam Eligibility

According to BCSP, to be eligible for CET, a candidate must:

- Have a minimum high school diploma
- Hold ASP, CDGP, CFPS, CHMM, CHST, CIH, CMIOSH, CRSP, CSP or OHST
- Have a minimum 270 hours training/teaching
- Pass a 4-hour multiple-choice CET Exam
