The following activities and subjects will be covered during the 5 day JPA:

Day One

Introduction to the Junior Police Academy, History of Policing, a Quick Guide to Being a Police Officer,

Patrolling the Streets/Hazards on Patrol, Traffic Enforcement 101, Law Enforcement's Many Hats

Day Two

SWAT (Tour of SWAT Van), K-9 Unit (K9 Demonstration), Legal Issues, The Bill of Rights & the Police

Day Three

Introduction to Criminal Investigations, Scene of the Crime, Crime Scene Investigation (Mock Crime Scene)

Day Four

Making the Arrest, Order in the Court (Mock Trial), Jail System (Tour of NPD Jail), Traffic Accident Investigation

Day Five

Introduction to Crime Prevention, Preventing School Violence, Teens and Drug Use, Police Officer Training Demonstrations, Graduation Ceremony (4 pm to 5 pm)

Lunch will be provided each day for JPA Cadets. Uniform shirts and backpacks containing academy supplies will also be provided at no cost to the JPA Cadets.
