- 26 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF HYDRANGEA
- 27 3 BEGONIA FLOWERS DISPLAYED
- 28 A VASE OF FERN FRONDS (max 5)
- 29 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF ROSES
- 30 ONE NAMED SPECIMEN ROSE
- 31 A VASE OF 3 STEMS, DIFFERENT FLOWERING SHRUBS
- 32 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF CONTRASTING FOLIAGE
- 33 1 FUCHSIA STEM (max height 46 cm measured from the table)
- 34 6 FUCHSIA FLOWERS DISPLAYED
- 35 AN ARRANGEMENT OF MIXED ORNAMENTAL GRASSES OR SEDGES (max width 30cm)
- 36 A VASE OF 3 STEMS OF A SINGLE KIND OF GARDEN FLOWER (excluding those in classes 23 - 35)
- 37 A VASE OF MIXED FLOWERS (judged on variety and quality of bloom)

### POT PLANTS

Classes 38 – 40 Max pot size 18cm diameter; max height of plant 60cm measured from the table

- 38 A FOLIAGE PLANT IN A POT
- 39 A NAMED FLOWERING POT PLANT
- 40 A SUCCULENT OR CACTUS
- 41 A PLANTED SUMMER FLOWERING CONTAINER FOR OUTSIDE DISPLAY

Jars must be plain, labelled including date (month and year made) and contents covered as shown

- 57 A JAR OF MARMALADE covered with wax disc and cellophane or screw top
- 58 A JAR OF FRUIT CURD covered with wax disc and cellophane
- 59 A JAR OF CHUTNEY covered with wax disc and cellophane
- 60 A JAR OF HONEY covered with screw top
