A local artist Stuart Langley won a commission via public vote to create a new public art sculpture as part of the upcoming regeneration of Seaton Carew. A piece of art to be made with thousands of pieces of local sea glass, custom cut steel and cast acrylic Stuart wanted school children to be a part of the finished sculpture by joining him on sea glass collections in Hartlepool. We took part in collecting sea glass at Middleton Beach for the sculpture. As part of the activity the children learnt about this fascinating material and will get the chance to see their finds encapsulated in the finished piece of public art when it is unveiled early 2018.
