Ad 8) During its annual meeting 2019 in Timisoara, on February 15-16, the Curatorium of the ESCT unanimously decided to propose as candidate **Margit Eckholt**, Osnabrück (DE). Born in 1960, she holds a PhD in Catholic Theology (Systematic Theology). In 2000 she obtained her habilitation at the Tübingen Faculty of Catholic Theology. From 2011 to august 2009 she has been professor of dogmatic theology at the Philosophisch-theologische Hochschule in Benediktbeuern, since September 2009, she is chair holder of the chair of Dogmatics and Fundamental Theology at the Institute of Catholic Theology of the Universität Osnabrück. She is a member of the German section of the ESCT since 1995 and has participated in different congresses of ESCT. Publisher of many works on systematic theology with a research focus in intercultural theology and perspectives of women in theology and church, Eckholt's publication list includes books and articles in refereed international journals. She has directed and supervised a number of research projects, and is involved in international collaborations with different Latin American Universities. She has been president of AGENDA-Forum katholischer Theologinnen (2015-2019), since 2002 she is president of ICALA - *Intercambio Cultural Alemán-Latinoamericano (Stipendienwerk Lateinamerika-Deutschland e.V)*, and she is vice-president of IIMF – *Internationales Institut für missionswissenschaftliche Forschungen..*
