Great performances by the kids- Jayla McWell and Mario Jr. we were very impressed with them, also A.J. Simpson another kid from GA had an outstanding day on the platform. Gloria Creekmore from TN came down and shattered some records in the masters 70-74 class and Latoya Atterberry also showed out in the full meet. Brad Dunn took home the best lifter award and just beat out Vemar Wilson by .20. Vemar did 215

pounds in the curl and also did 17 reps with 280 lbs, very impressive! Ben Chambers and James McLendon both came out on top with impressive deadlifts. Tee Meyers 62 years old and lifting 700 lbs, what else can you say, super impressive! Wyatt Gresham from GA, 71 years old totaled 975 lbs in the 198 class. Marvin Brand and Eric Chaney went nose to nose and they finished with 1,425 & 1,430 totals with Eric beating Marvin out by .10 for best lifter. Duane "The Driz" Drisdorn FINALLY deadlifted 500 pounds, congrats. Tony Greene from SC came down and posted some impressive numbers as well as Tim Prather from GA posting a 1,250 total. Michael Shelton from GA. Took home the best lifter award and came close with a 600 lb deadlift. Ryan Ward from SC curled 150 pounds for first place. Lorenzo Parker couldn't complete a bench press to stay in the meet and I'm sure Lorenzo will be back stronger in the next WNPf meet. Brian Stewart pushed his total up from March and did a 1,295 total. Eddie Washington posted an impressive 965 pounds. Mario McWell Sr, totaled 1425 and won the best lifter award in the raw division.
