The Lake




The Fetzer-See consists of approximately 110 acre of water area. It is situated in Bavaria (Schwaben) between the south german cities of Günzburg und Dillingen and meets all the needs for water skiing.



The Club

The Waterski Club Fetzer-See e.V. (WSCFS e.V.) was founded by Thomas and Alexander Fetzer in 2005. Te Idea was to enable water sports behind a boat for everyone — not only accessible for semi professional or professional skiers. The location is an official training center and competition site of the German Waterski and Wakeboard federation (DWWV e.V.) for national and international competition sport.

The Competition

The National Championships will be held as a two rounds competition (best of two rounds) in following divisions: open women, open men, junior girls, junior boys, senior women and senior men.

The open international competition will also be a two rounds competition and extra trophies but only open and juniors.

Schedule:

The competition will start on Friday.



The boom competition will be a two rounds trick competition on the boom, with or without handle, boys and girls together. The age limit to enter is 13.

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, drug controls can be conducted during this competition. By entering this competition all athletes agree to be subject to doping control. Information about the IWWF Anti-Doping program can be found at: http://iwwf.sport/athletes/anti-doping/ where you will also find a direct link to the list of all prohibited substances.

The Entry Fee

The entry fee will be 40,-€ per discipline or 120,-€ for all three events. For juniors the entry fee will be 30,-€ per discipline and 90,-€ for all three events. The entry form needs to be sent to the organizer and to the national barefoot council by 01.06.2019 and the fee must be transferred to the organizers bank account by the date. The organizer will charge an extra fee of 40,-€ for late entries.

Each registered skier needs to be in possession of a skiing license (from their federation) and a valid insurance.
