“Let Me Help You” (Story by Chad Fleck)

Open in an emergency room with a man who has no clue who he is or where he was. We learn that he has messed with alcohol and drugs for too long as the Doctor (the passenger Uber from Episode 1) explains to him the severity of the situation. A couple flashbacks of his life and the decisions that brought him to this point. He is now left with one ultimate decision, get help and survive, or ignore the help and die. It shows that it is never too late to ask for help.

“Patience on Aisle 5” (Story by Chad Fleck)

At a crowded popular grocery store on a Saturday. Mother with 3 struggling children giving her a head is about to lose it, being in a hurry, runs her cart in to the back of a man’s ankles (Uber Driver) He acts like he didn’t feel anything. We follow him through his grocery store experience with nothing but unfortunate, annoyances occurring. Not just from some of the patrons, but from a rude employee. He maintains his cool. On the way out we see him helping an elderly lady with her groceries. It’s a calming lesson on how to maintain your patience, and still continue to do good, even if the ones around you are trying to stop you.

Flash forward to a frantic Wife trying to reach her Husband, without any reply. Cut to the same man, somewhat stumbling into a garage. Fast forward to present time, the camera zooms out from the hands and gun to reveal it was the fired employee from earlier. He is laying on his back sobbing. Dramatic music begins to softly play, but intensifies as he begins get up on his knees, he looks up to the sky, and then lower his head.

Music intensifies even more as you see the gun begin to enter the picture frame being placed against the man's head. His tears are flowing and his breathing is becoming more rapid and rapid. Music hits its peak, as the camera zooms in tighter. The man sits like this for a few seconds in suspense and then collapses as he drops the gun. The music stops. Camera snaps to black.

"As Time Goes By" (Story by Ben Morris)

One continuous shot of two married people walking through same crowded street or sitting on a park bench from days of old to first date. We see them encounter all of the joys and pains throughout this 50 year span. A person walking in front of them will "wipe" us to another span in their life. Some of the characters that we've previously encountered can also be seen at various stages of their lives. A Celebration episode, honoring all of those who have decided to Love, no matter what and show that Love truly does conquer all.
