The first grade students are learning about jobs in our community. To help our students develop a clearer understanding about our community, each student will complete a home project. The project should be student created, not store bought. The instructions for the project are below.

First, choose a place in the community. Here are some ideas:

Second, get a box (shoe box). Paint the box or cover it with paper. Decorate the box to look like the place you chose in the community. You may glue the box to a piece of cardboard for the ground. Glue signs on the building to show what the name of the place is. Use your imagination when coming up with a name.

Next, use the paper doll that is attached to this project information sheet and dress the doll to reflect what the community worker would wear. This worker should match the building you constructed.

Last, be prepared to give a presentation to the class about your project. Use complete sentences to tell the following information:

- ☐ Which community worker works in the building?
- ☐ Describe the community workers job and the tools they use to do it.
- ☐ Why is the building and job important to the community?
