### Late Pick Up's

As per our policy please pick up your children based on your booked times.

Our late pick up fee is \$15 per child for every 10mins after your booked/enrolled time.

### Children Sick or Absent

If your child is sick or feeling unwell "Please do not bring them in".

Please phone to advise our staff by 9am of the illness and when they will be returning.

If you are not bringing in your child on any booked day please phone, text or email with the reason of absences.

### Wearing Seatbelts / Car Seats

We recognize that for Safety in a vehicle, your child needs to be restrained from birth till their 7<sup>th</sup> birthday in an approved car seat in accordance with the NZ Transport Agency.
