# THE LOIRE VALLEY: CHATEAUX, VINEYARDS & FORESTS OF FRANCE 02-06 May 2019

# Day 1: May 2<sup>nd</sup>, Thursday

## **⇒** Leave London

Leave London St Pancras by Eurostar. Arrive in Paris. Take the TGV from Paris to Tours. Or fly to Tours Loire Valley Airport direct from Stansted. We then go on an evening walk & dinner in Tours

Day 2: May 3rd, Friday

Walk around the Cher valley starting at the world famous Chateau of Chenonceaux, which we will visit.



An architectural masterpiece, property of the Crown and then a royal residence, Château de Chenonceau is a truly exceptional site by its original design, but also its history: loved, managed and protected by women, including Diane of Poitiers and Catherine de Medicis, it is also known as the 'Château des Dames'. The feminine touch is everywhere; it has protected the Château from the ravages of war and made it a peaceful place.

We will stroll around the Chateau and surrounding countryside.

# Day 3: May 4th, Saturday

Walk around the forests of Chambord (still a hunting ground for French presidents) and visit Chateau Chambord.



We then subject to the schedule have the possibility of enjoying some jousting shows or strolling in a boat on the beuvron river.

The Château de Chambord is one of the most recognisable châteaux in the world because of its very distinctive French Renaissance architecture which blends traditional French medieval forms with classical Renaissance structures. The building, which was never completed, was constructed by King Francis I of France.

# Day 4: May 5th, Sunday

We start our leisurely day by visiting the Unesco world heritage gardens of Villandry, then move on to visit the unique Chateau d'Azay le Rideau.

The Chateau of Villandry is the last of the great chateaux of the Loire built during the Renaissance in the Loire Valley. The sober elegance of its architecture combined with the charm of its outstanding gardens make this one of the jewels of world heritage.



The Château d'Azay-le-Rideau was built on an island in the Indre River under the patronage of King Francis the First. A subtle blend of French tradition and innovative Italian decor, it is an icon of the new art of building in the Loire Valley in the 16th century. Its successive owners have helped to make it the most architecturally harmonious treasure in the Loire Valley. In 1905, the Château d'Azay-le-Rideau came under State ownership.



We will end our week-end on the Loire valley by a wine tasting in the Vouvray troglodyte cellar one of the most famous wines of the Loire Valley.
