CHALLENGE

When HCM Architects visited Pictura Interiors they realized the possibility of printing multi layer imagery onto a variety of materials. They were looking for a unique stylized map/photo illustration for two large wall sections in the City Point Bar at MSP International Airport, Terminal One. PROCESS

Using a combination of iconic twin cities landmark images and historic map illustrations, Pictura Interiors created four truly custom photo illustrations. These original high resolution graphics were printed directly on to acrylic material using UV technology, and at over 6 feet tall, they really deliver dynamic visual impact in the finished space. "The result is a very clean, stylistic approach to acrylic prints." said Ted Wright. "Going in we understood the challenge with this space.
