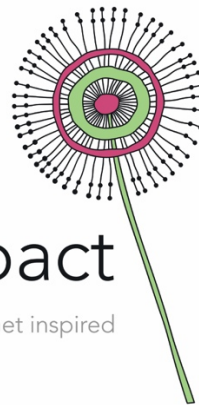

This research will develop dairy farming interventions that can increase the resilience and sustainability of production in the face of difficult to predict interactions between environmental, social and market forces.

This will provide benefits to UK dairy farmers (who will receive additional payments based on the implementation of interventions), dairy processors, manufacturers and retailers (who will increase the resilience of their milk supply chain) and policy makers (who will benefit from evidence on the public goods provided by existing and new post-Brexit agri-environment scheme options).

To deliver these benefits, we will develop scalable new pricing models to generate new income for farmers whilst increasing security of milk supplies and protecting natural capital. This will build on the Landscape Enterprise Network approach being pioneered and tested in our study sites. We will develop policy briefs, input to expert groups, consultations and select committees, for example Defra's Social Science Expert Group and Scottish Government's Strategic Research Programme Board.
