



## **Minecraft workshop installation requirements**

### **Software Requirements**

To maximize time for learning and play in the workshop, the following software should be installed on your laptop:

In case you have any trouble with the installation, please don't worry - just bring your laptop and we will help you on the day of the workshop.

### **Minecraft**

Please verify that Minecraft is installed on the laptop and that your child can sign in with their Minecraft username and password. You can download the latest version from:

<https://minecraft.net/download>

When you have successfully signed in, you should see a welcome message and 'Ready to play Minecraft 1.9' at the bottom-right hand corner of the Minecraft launcher. If you see a different version number, go to 'Edit Profile' and make sure 'Use Latest Version' is selected. Then click on 'Save Profile'.



### **Python**

Run the Python 3.5.1 installer

### **Java 8**

Our Minecraft server requires Java. To check you are running the latest version:

- On Windows: Open Windows Control Panel, find Java (it may be inside the Programs category), and click on 'Update Now'.
- On Mac: Open System Preferences, click on Java and then click on the Update Now button.
