# Welcome to Dover AFB Fam Camp

The Dover AFB FAM Camp is located at the south end of the base along perimeter road. The camp has 10 recreational vehicle sites with electric (30/50 amp connections), water and sewage hook-ups. Picnic tables and grills are located near each site. There is also an overflow area where we allow “dry camping” (meaning no utilities), a dump station, large dumpster and a bathhouse with flush toilets, showers and a coin operated laundry.

Just across the street you will find Eagles’ Nest Park which is equipped with several pavilions, (that can be reserved, at no cost through ODR), horseshoe pits, volleyball nets, and playgrounds that can accommodate children 2 - 12 years of age.

Just down the street is the Air Mobility Command Museum. Here you will find a collection of vintage aircraft and memorabilia that reflect the history of Dover AFB and the USAF airlift mission. Admission is free and access to the museum is off route 9 to the south off the base (no entry available from on-base).

Dover area attractions include Dover Downs, which hosts NASCAR each June and September followed by harness racing November - March, with slot machines and dining available every day.

Our FAM Camp is just 45 minutes away from Rehoboth and Dewey Beaches, which are rated among the top ten beaches in the US.



## Registration

Our FAM Camp is a first-come, first service camp. We do not take reservations. Campers are required to register at Outdoor Recreation (475 Chevron Ave) if paying by credit card or use the on-site registration drop box (paying by cash or check). Check-out time is by noon each day. Campers departing after noon will be charged an additional days fee.

Occupancy is limited to 30 days unless a long-term site is available (limited to 4 sites) and the camper has coordinated with the ODR manager in advance.

## Payments

Payments are required in advance of your stay. Rates are as follows:

Camp Site	\$20/day
Off-Site w/Shared Utilities*	\$15/day
Overflow RV (No Utilities)	\$8/day
Tent Camp (No utilities)	\$8/day
Dump Station	\$3/per use

\*Must have permission of site occupants

## Speed Limit

The speed limit is 5 mph.

## Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are from 2300–0700hrs (11 pm – 7 am). Please refrain from activities which cause noise and could disturb other guests.

## Fires

Open/ground fires are NOT permitted in the FAM Camp. Barbecue grills are provided at each site. Personal grills are also permissible. Do NOT place hot coals in dumpster.

## Children

Adult sponsors are responsible for the safe and proper conduct of their children

## Pets

All pets, including cats, must be on a leash no longer than six (6) feet in length when outside. Pets are not permitted in the bath house or laundry. All pet droppings must be picked up IMMEDIATELY, bagged, and properly disposed of in dumpsters.

Campers may not board dogs of any breed (or mixed breed) that are deemed “aggressive or potentially aggressive.” Prohibited dog breeds include but may not be limited to: Pit Bull (American and English Staffordshire Bull Terrier), Rottweiler, Doberman Pinscher, Chow and Wolf Hybrids. Other breeds of dogs or individual dogs that demonstrate dominant or aggressive behavior (i.e. biting, growling, snarling, etc.) while at the FAM Camp may be prohibited at the discretion of the ODR manager.

## Cleaning Responsibilities

Customers are responsible for keeping their sites clean and free of debris. A dumpster is located near the dump station for FAM Camp use. DO NOT leave/abandon items at camp site when you depart.
