
## How did ET get its start?

Allan Dayhoff, DMin., pastor and author, developed the seminar, Evangelize Today, after completing his dissertation for his **Doctor of Ministries at Covenant** Theological Seminary. His thesis, "Confrontational monologue vs. relational dialogue as it relates to evangelism," explored the different methods for evangelism within the Christian church. The findings in his paper birthed an evangelism program called "Decision to disciple," which later became "Evangelize Today." A number of seminars and training sessions have been held over these past 15 years, helping to breathe new life into the great commission as stated in Matthew 28. Dr. Dayhoff has served as the church-planting pastor of Grace Fellowship Church in Chantilly, VA since 1990. ### Evangelism Training Events

Evangelize Today (ET) seeks to partner with individuals, churches and ministry organizations to propose and

jointly experience what evangelism could look like in the post Christian era. Our Evangelism Training Events provide a progressive method in teaching a fresh way to become involved in meaningful encounters with the non-Christian.

Research & Discovery Day is an event presenting research from thousands of ET evangelism encounters in our seminars and through our ET Residents' fieldwork. Participants will wrestle with questions like "where are we with evangelism in the post-Christian age?" and "why are our churches shrinking?" Most find our research engaging, provoking such questions as, "what is the answer to the current Evangelism landscape?" The presentation is available to leadership teams, ministry staff, pastoral networks and churches. Prices available upon request. Typically 5 hours.

**Regional "Round Table"** is a "Q&A" discussion on the topic of evangelism. ET has discovered in Christians a pent-up desire to talk, debate, and share frustrations about this topic of sharing our faith with the non-Christian world. Our research has uncovered that 82% of the population do not regularly attend a religious service . . . and they are not coming back to our church buildings. If that's true, how do we approach evangelism, outreach programs, employment for seminary grads and the future of our ministries? This gathering often follows our "Research & Discovery Day." *Price: FREE. Typically about 2.5 hours.* 

The Evangelize Today Seminar is our core teaching event. Together, the group completes six interactive projects, which includes a live phone call to ask spiritual questions to a non-Christian. The seminar ends with time to draft a hand-written response letter back to the person called. The seminar leader also makes a call and writes a letter. ET has partnered with several dozen churches and organizations over the past five years. The hosts and attenders experience a quality, user-friendly, and at times, life-altering seminar. The topics in an ET seminar are listed on the front flap of this brochure.

Prices available upon request. Typically about 9 hours of training over a day and a half (often a Friday evening/Saturday).

**ET Conference** combines the above three events, often in a Thursday, Friday, Saturday format. The Friday night and Saturday seminar is the core event and often draws the most attenders. Many who attend the Research Day and Round Table either attend the seminar or look for a time to host their own ET conference.
