## WHAT WE DO ACCEPT

We may pass on seasonal items and things we have a lot of in stock.  
We suggest calling before coming to the store.

- ❑ **Appliances:** Working and clean. For non-working appliances a recycling donation of \$5 for appliances, \$15 for refrigerators is appreciated.
- ❑ **Batteries:** Household use type. A recycling donation is appreciated.
- ❑ **Bed frames:** Complete with all parts.
- ❑ **Bikes, tricycles:** Working or non-working in good shape.
- ❑ **Blinds:** Working, made of wood, with all parts, in good shape.
- ❑ **Cabinets and counters:** Good shape, made of plywood.
- ❑ **Carpet and rugs:** Good condition, no stains, rips, holes or smell.
- ❑ **Doors:** Good condition, with or without frame and hardware.
- ❑ **Electrical**
- ❑ **Exercise equipment:** Working or non-working.
- ❑ **Flooring:** Full lengths, enough to cover a 6x6' space.
- ❑ **Garden supplies:** Tools, pots, yard art, stepping stones, composters, etc.
- ❑ **Hardware**
- ❑ **Lawn equipment:** Working, in good condition.
- ❑ **Lights:** CFL bulbs, fluorescent tubes. Working and non-working.
- ❑ **Light fixtures, lamps and parts:** Working, in good condition.
- ❑ **Lumber (dimensional):** Longer than 4', no nails, little decomposition.
- ❑ **Metal (scrap)**
- ❑ **Mattresses, box springs:** Good condition, no stains, rips, holes or smell.
- ❑ **Paint, stains, adhesives, solvents, sealants, finishes:** At least ½ filled cans with the label on, the lid well sealed with no rust.
- ❑ **Plumbing parts**
- ❑ **PVC pipe:** At least 4' in length.
- ❑ **Stuffed furniture:** Good condition, no stains, rips, holes or smell.
- ❑ **Sheet goods:** Plywood, hardy board, dry wall, siding, etc. At least ½ of a sheet in good shape.
- ❑ **Shoes:** Any condition.
- ❑ **Sinks, tubs, shower surrounds:** Good shape, with or without hardware.
- ❑ **Sporting goods**
- ❑ **Tile:** Good condition, clean, enough to cover a 6x6' space.
- ❑ **Toilets:** Tall or unique, in good shape, complete with hardware.

## WHAT WE DON'T ACCEPT

This is a *partial* list of what we can't accept. The wide variety of donations we get makes it impossible to list it all. The items with no explanation why we don't take them are things that simply don't sell.

- ❑ **Appliances (small):** Coffee makers, blenders, toasters, timers, etc. They often don't work and we simply don't have time to fix them.
- ❑ **Auto parts**
- ❑ **Books, magazines, photo albums, paper goods**
- ❑ **CDs, DVDs, record albums, VHS and cassette tapes**
- ❑ **Chemicals & unlabeled chemical products**
- ❑ **Child car seats:** Prohibited by law.
- ❑ **Child cribs:** Prohibited by law.
- ❑ **CO2 detectors:** Prohibited by law.
- ❑ **Electronics:** Computers, printers, monitors, TVs, stereos, boom boxes, speakers, computerized or electronic toys, alarm clocks, etc.
- ❑ **Fabric items:** Clothing, curtains, bedding/pillows, stuffed toys, table cloths/napkins, furniture covers, wall hangings, afghans, etc.
- ❑ **Fire extinguishers (expired):** They can't be recharged.
- ❑ **Food preparation/cooking/serving:** Dishes, cookware, utensils, silverware, cutlery, food storage, etc.
- ❑ **Furniture (disassembled):** We regret that we don't have time to assemble them. The parts get scattered or are sold separately.
- ❑ **Kick knacks:** Vases, figurines, fake flowers, dolls, etc.
- ❑ **Particle board:** Furniture, shelving and sheet goods. Getting wet destroys it, it falls apart when moved, contains formaldehyde.
- ❑ **Personal use items & products:** Jewelry, purses, belts, cosmetics, hair/skin care products, drugs/supplements, etc.
- ❑ **Smoke detectors:** Prohibited by law.
- ❑ **Unsafe items:** Tools, electrical equipment, appliances. We regret that we don't have time to make repairs.

## WHAT WE DO ACCEPT (CONTINUED)

- ❑ **Tools:** Working power and hand tools.
- ❑ **Windows:** Vinyl and wood, not failed.
- ❑ **Wood furniture:** Complete, assembled, structurally intact, no particle board.
