### **Extra Credit Opportunities**

In performance based classes where a larger portion of the grade is dependent on being at performances and just a few rehearsals a week, there can be a significant impact on your grade. Participation in class includes being prepared and present while also being engaged and productive. Music ensembles rely heavily on every single member being present and this means we hurt every time even just one person misses something.

It is never my desire for a student not to succeed academically; so here are a few opportunities for you to fix your grade due to missed rehearsals that were not due to an illness or excused by Mr. Cook because it fits the parameters laid out in the handbook.

#### **Participate in an extra performance –**

***Value = One rehearsal make-up, 1/4 of a performance make-up.***

This may include community performances with large or small ensembles that are not already scheduled in the handbook. This also would include volunteering for away football game pep bands as well.

#### **Concert Report –**

***Value = Two rehearsals, 1/2 of a performance make-up.***

Go to a concert of any kind and write a concert report about the concert, repertoire that was played, instrumentation, something that went well or did not go well. Write about the stage presence of the performers as well as performance quality. Be constructive with criticism and articulate why something may have gone right or wrong. Concerts can be from many genre's and can be professional, college or high school concerts from around the area. I highly encourage you to see and support live music whenever possible despite needing the extra credit or not.

The report should be 2 pages, double spaced, 12 point times new roman font. You must include a program or ticket from the concert along with your report.
