WHAT IS COLOR GUARD?

Color Guard combines modern dance and theatrical performance elements with colorful flags, costumes and props to create a fun and exciting visual performance.

> In the fall, the color guard performs with the ACHS marching band in a field presentation lasting about 7-8 minutes. Fall performances include home football games, field show competitions and local parades.

In the winter/spring the color guard moves indoors to develop a winter quard show – a routine about 4-5 minutes long performed to a recorded soundtrack. Guard members perform this show at competitions throughout Southern California. (The ACHS color guard was recently awarded a Gold Medal for their performance at the WGASC (hampionships.)
