- Please include a salutation and closing within the dedication (the message should clearly state who the dedication is "to" and "from")



Drop-off / Pick-up Reminders

From time to time, I need to publish reminders for all of us regarding our “parking lot etiquette.” Please remember that ultimately, this is a student safety issue, and we are trying to make sure that all of our kids are safe. Whether you are on our driveway, in our parking lot, at the church or the park, please drive slowly and watch out for students. Additionally:

1. The Speed limit on our driveway and within our parking lot is 5 mph. Please DO NOT exceed this.
2. When walking within our parking lot, please use the designated crosswalks.
3. Please do not leave your car unattended during pick-up - if you need to park, please use a designated parking spot at the school, church or park.
4. Our “through traffic” lane starts after the Preschool Driveway - not up by the church parking lot.
