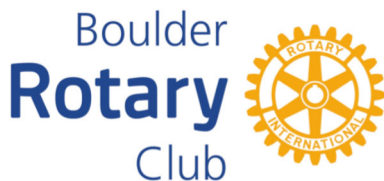

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# Cameron van Reyk

## Music Adjudicator (Vocal & Instrumental)



Cameron van Reyk first started his choral life as a treble in the St. Mary's Cathedral choir in 1995. He has competed in International Music Festivals both in Sydney and Wales and in 2000 Cameron toured Europe and had the pleasure of singing for Pope John Paul II in a Canonization Mass in Rome. Whilst developing his choral skills, Cameron took up the saxophone and in 2010 he completed a Bachelor of Music (Jazz) at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts.

Cameron was a founding member of the acapella male quartet *Quartessence* which released their debut album 'Tenebrae Reflections' in 2011. He was a founding member of *Voyces* and is the current Musical Director of *Lumina* who will be launching their self-titled debut album this October. He is also musical director of several community choirs around Perth.

Cameron is a passionate music educator and has been a choral specialist at schools including Corpus Christi College and St. Stephen's School Carramar. Currently he is a classroom music teacher and Band and Wind Specialist at Perth College.
